# e-Invoicing

An electronic invoice is a functional equivalent of an invoice on paper, characterized by being sent to the receiver by electronic means, preserving identical legal value and providing new security conditions.

Different factors can influence the way invoices are exchanged:



Mandatory



Prior administrative procedures



Invoice format



Fiscal control code



Electronic signature



## e-Invoicing - Italy

#### Similar requirement as in Spain:

- Mandatory fixed XML message structure "FatturaPA"
- WebServices connection to the SDI central platform

#### **Differences:**

One central platform vs. several platforms in Spain




## e-Invoicing - France

#### Similar requirement as in Spain/Italy:

- Mandatory fixed XML message structure
- WebServices connection to the Chorus central platform

#### **Differences:**

- One central platform vs. several platforms in Spain
- Gradual implementation per company profile/ size



## e-Invoicing - UK

#### Similar e-invoicing requirement as in Spain/Italy/France:

Mandatory fixed XML message structure – PEPPOL\*

#### **Differences:**

- Only for Public Healthcare Sector, not for other Public Administrations
- Mandatory messages: invoice, order, order change, and credit note:


#### **NHS E-Procurement Strategy**


- PEPPOL (AS2) connection to the Access Points







